Serving the Nation

Hands-on projects where participants provide direct assistance, such as:

- Gilat & Shuva Junctions – serving IDF soldiers on a short respite from the conflict
- Caring for children from surrounding nations staying in Israel for lifesaving cardiac surgery
- Helping meet the needs of those making Aliyah
- Working at Heritage Forests & Farm, an organic tree farm on the Golan Heights
- Distributing food in Sderot and Ashdod to those who recently made Aliyah from Russia and Ukraine.
- Lone Soldiers – providing emergency relief supplies to IDF without family support in Israel
- Providing financial support to meet essential needs of those living in the land
